Submission of full papers (not more than 5 pages) with an abstract in approximately 200 words, keywords (minimum 5) and references on A4 size paper with margin 1.5” inch on all sides in MS Word format with font-Times New Roman, size-12 & line spacing-single. Length of the paper should not exceed 2000 words. Details such as name of the author, designation, title of the article, abstract, name of the affiliating institution, mailing address, telephone number, and Email address are to be included. The Manuscript/ Paper should not be plagiarized (Maximum Upto 10% acceptable). The paper submitted must not have been previously published, presented elsewhere or under consideration at any platform. The selected papers will be published in UGC CARE listed journal. In case of co-author papers, it is mandatory that at least one author of the paper should register for the conference. Certificates will be issued only to registered participants. The Paper Contributors are requested to follow APA Latest edition for referencing.
